

InVision Global – Website Privacy Policy

Introduction

Your privacy is important to us at Invision Brands LTD, LLC d/b/a InVision Global (“**InVision Global**,” “**Company**,” or “**We**”). We are committed to protecting your privacy through our compliance with this policy.

This policy describes the types of information we may collect from you or that you may provide when you visit the website <https://invisionglobal.raveretailer.net> (our “**Website**”), our practices for collecting, using, maintaining, protecting, and disclosing that information, and includes information on your California Privacy Rights.

We reserve the right to make changes to this policy from time to time without prior notice to you. Any changes will take effect immediately upon posting the revised privacy policy. However, we will not use your personal information in a manner materially different than what was stated when it was collected unless you consent.

Notice

Our Website is not intended for children under 18 years of age. We do not knowingly collect personal information from children under 18. If you are under 18, do not use or provide any information on this Website or provide any information about yourself to us, including your name, address, telephone number, email address, or any screen name or username you may use. If we learn we have collected or received personal information from a child under 18 without verification of parental consent, we will delete that information. This Website is operated in the United States (US) and is intended for users located in the US.

Type and Nature of Information Collected and Processed

We collect several types of information from and about users of our Website or through your communication with us, including:

- “**Personal Information**” including information by which you may be personally identified, such as your name, postal address, e-mail address, or telephone number; and
- “**Additional Information**” including information that is about you but individually does not identify you and information about your internet connection, the equipment you use to access our Website, and usage details.

How We Collect Information

We collect this information:

1. Directly from you when you provide it to us.
2. Automatically as you navigate through the site. Information collected automatically may include usage details, IP addresses, and information collected through cookies, web beacons, and other tracking technologies.

3. From third parties, for example, our business partners.

1. Information You Provide to Us

The information we collect on or through our Website may include:

- Information that you provide by filling in forms on our Website. This includes information provided when you apply to become an InVision Global Affiliate, at the time of registering to use our Website, subscribing to our service, posting material, or requesting further services. We may also ask you for information when you enter a promotion sponsored by us and when you report a problem with our Website.
- Records and copies of your correspondence (including email addresses) if you contact us.
- Your responses to surveys that we might ask you to complete for research purposes.
- Details of transactions you carry out through our Website and of the fulfillment of your orders. You may be required to provide financial information before placing an order through our Website.
- Your search queries on the Website.
- You also may opt to provide information to be published or displayed (hereinafter, “**posted**”) on public areas of the Website or transmitted to other users of the Website or third parties (collectively, “**User Contributions**”). Your User Contributions are posted on and transmitted to others at your own risk. Although we limit access to certain pages, please be aware that no security measures are perfect or impenetrable. Additionally, we cannot control the actions of other users of the Website with whom you may choose to share your User Contributions. Therefore, we cannot and do not guarantee that your User Contributions will not be viewed by unauthorized persons.

2. Information We Collect Through Automatic Data Collection Technologies

As you navigate through and interact with our Website, we may use automatic data collection technologies to collect certain information about your equipment, browsing actions, and patterns, including:

- Details of your visits to our Website and other communication data and the resources that you access and use on the Website.
- Information about your computer and internet connection, including your IP address, operating system, and browser type.

We also may use these technologies to collect information about your online activities over time and across third-party websites or other online services (behavioral tracking). We do not respond to Do Not Track requests.

The information we collect automatically may include personal information, or we may maintain it or associate it with personal information we collect in other ways or that we receive from third parties. It helps us to improve our Website and to deliver a better and more personalized service, including by enabling us to:

- Estimate our audience size and usage patterns.
- Store information about your preferences, allowing us to customize our Website according to your individual interests.
- Speed up your searches.

- Recognize you when you return to our Website.

The technologies we use for this automatic data collection may include:

- **Cookies (or browser cookies).** A cookie is a small file placed on the hard drive of your computer. You may refuse to accept browser cookies by activating the appropriate setting on your browser. However, if you select this setting, you may be unable to access certain parts of our Website. Unless you have adjusted your browser setting so that it will refuse cookies, our system will issue cookies when you direct your browser to our Website.
- **Flash Cookies.** Certain features of our Website may use local stored objects (or Flash cookies) to collect and store information about your preferences and navigation to, from, and on our Website. Flash cookies are not managed by the same browser settings as are used for browser cookies. - **Web Beacons.** Pages of our Website may contain small electronic files known as web beacons (also referred to as clear gifs, pixel tags, and single-pixel gifs) that permit the Company, for example, to count users who have visited those pages and for other related website statistics (for example, recording the popularity of certain Website content and verifying system and server integrity).

3. Third-Party Use of Cookies and Other Tracking Technologies

Some content or applications on the Website are served by third parties, including advertisers, ad networks and servers, content providers, and application providers. These third parties may use cookies to collect information about you when you use our Website. The information they collect may be associated with your personal information or they may collect information, including personal information, about your online activities over time and across different websites and other online services. They may use this information to provide you with interest-based (behavioral) advertising or other targeted content.

We do not control third-party tracking technologies or how they may be used. If you have any questions about an advertisement or other targeted content, you should contact the responsible provider directly. How We Use Your Information

We use information that we collect about you or that you provide to us, including any personal information:

- To present our Website and its contents to you.
- To provide you with information, products, or services that you request from us.
- To fulfill any other purpose for which you provide it.
- To provide you with notices about your account.
- To carry out our obligations and enforce our rights arising from any contracts entered into between you and us, including for billing and collection.
- To notify you about changes to our Website or any products or services we offer or provide through it.
- In any other way that we may describe when you provide the information.
- For any other purpose with your consent.

We may also use your information to contact you about our own goods and services that may be of interest to you. If you do not want us to use your information in this way, please adjust your user preferences in your account profile. We may use the information we have collected from you to enable us to display advertisements to our advertisers' target audiences. Even though we do not disclose your personal information for these purposes without your consent, if you click on or otherwise interact with an advertisement, the advertiser may assume that you meet its target criteria.

Disclosure of Your Information

We may disclose personal information that we collect, or you provide as described in this privacy policy as follows:

- To InVision Global's employees and third parties who provide technical or organizational services for InVision Global and are required and have agreed to protect your data.
- We grant rights to sell InVision products to independent distributors (each an "**InVision Global Affiliate**"). InVision Global Affiliates are not employees of InVision Global. Therefore, we have no control over the collection, use, or disclosure of personal information by InVision Global Affiliates for marketing or other purposes, nor do we assume any responsibility or liability for this. If you provide an InVision Global Affiliate with information through this website, we will have access to this information and the information will be handled in accordance with this privacy policy. InVision Global Affiliates may provide InVision Global with information about their customers, which we will handle in accordance with this website privacy policy upon receipt of the information. If you are a customer of an InVision Global Affiliate, please contact your InVision Global Affiliate directly to learn about their data protection practices.
- In the case of payment processing for orders, the data for processing the payment transaction is passed on to the payment service provider who is bound by instructions. The InVision Global Affiliate through whom you place an online order is only informed whether the transaction has been completed. Your InVision Global Affiliate will not receive any information about your account unless you provided your information directly to the InVision Global Affiliate or have given your consent in advance.
- To companies such as shipping companies for transporting orders and credit card companies for billing. These service providers are prohibited from using your personal information.
- In the case of a merger, acquisition by another company, or sale of all or part of InVision Global's assets, in which case your personal information may also be included in the transferred assets.
- To our subsidiaries and affiliates.
- To contractors, service providers, and other third parties we use to support our business and who are bound by contractual obligations to keep personal information confidential and use it only for the purposes for which we disclose it to them.
- To third parties to market their products or services to you if you have not opted out of these disclosures. We contractually require these third parties to keep personal information confidential and use it only for the purposes for which we disclose it to them. - To fulfill the purpose for which you provide it.

- For any other purpose disclosed by us when you provide the information.
- With your consent.

We may also disclose your personal information:

- To comply with any court order, law, or legal process, including to respond to any government or regulatory request.

- If we believe disclosure is necessary or appropriate to protect the rights, property, or safety of InVision Global, our customers, or others.

Choices About How We Use and Disclose Your Information

We strive to provide you with choices regarding the personal information you provide to us. We have created mechanisms to provide you with the following control over your information:

- **Tracking Technologies and Advertising.** You can set your browser to refuse all or some browser cookies or to alert you when cookies are being sent. If you disable or refuse cookies, please note that some parts of this site may then be inaccessible or not function properly.
- **Disclosure of Your Information for Third-Party Advertising.** If you do not want us to share your personal information with unaffiliated or non-agent third parties for promotional purposes, you can opt-out by checking the relevant box located on the form on which we collect your data (the order form or registration form). We do not control third-party collection or use of your information to serve interest-based advertising. We may not accommodate a request to change information if we believe the change would violate any law or legal requirement or cause the information to be incorrect.

If you delete your User Contributions from the Website, copies of your User Contributions may remain viewable in cached and archived pages or might have been copied or stored by other Website users. Your California Privacy Rights

If you are a California resident, California law may provide you with additional rights regarding our use of your personal information.

This section applies to California residents only and supplements the information contained in this privacy policy. The California Consumer Privacy Act 2018 (the “CCPA”) grants specific rights to California residents and requires that we make certain disclosures.

If you are a California resident, you have the right to (i) request that we delete personal data that we have collected about you; (ii) request that we disclose the personal data we have collected about you; (iii) request that we disclose whether we sell (or sold) your personal data; (iv) opt-out of the sale of your personal data (to the extent we sell your personal data); and (v) not face discrimination for exercising your rights under the CCPA.

With respect to the sale of personal data, the CCPA defines “sale” or “sell” broadly to cover scenarios that are traditionally not considered a sale of personal data. Accordingly, there may be instances where we sell (as that term is defined under the CCPA) personal data. We collect the following categories of personal data directly from you and indirectly from you (e.g., by observing your actions on our Website): (i) identifiers, which includes the following specific pieces of personal data: name, email address, street address, and telephone number; (ii) bank card information, which includes the following specific pieces of personal data: name, card number, and other financial information; (iii) commercial information, which includes the following specific pieces of personal data: products or services purchased or considered or other purchasing or consuming history or tendency; and (iv) internet or other electronic network activity information, which includes the following specific pieces of personal data: browsing history, search history, and information regarding your interaction with this Website.

The purposes for collecting and selling (as that term is defined by the CCPA) personal data and how we use and share personal data are outlined in this privacy policy.

In the preceding twelve months, we have not collected personal information through this Website nor have we sold any categories of personal information.

California's “Shine the Light” law (Civil Code Section § 1798.83) permits users of our Website that are California residents to request certain information regarding our disclosure of personal information to
