Cell Defender for Pets

Pets living outdoors are exposed to air filled with lead particles from exhaust fumes and herbicides and pesticides blown from nearby farms and yards as well as weather-treated wood. This last item is very important: wood used outdoors is treated with arsenic to reduce termite damage. As pets play with their chew toys and they roll around on the deck, the toys will absorb arsenic, which your pet can then ingest into their system. Therefore, if you have a wooden deck, do not allow your pets to play with chew toys on that deck.

Not to mention, if we take our pets out for a walk and they lick their paws, they may become exposed to everything they trotted through, including chemical-saturated runoff from yards and golf courses, as well as oil and gasoline residue.

There are very few things that we can use to treat pain in our pets. For dogs, your veterinarian would probably give you a narcotic, such as Tramadol or Demerol. These make your dog sleepy and can cause terrible side effects. The vet may also prescribe an NSAID (non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drug). These



also have limited efficacy and terrible side effects, mostly digestive issues like diarrhea. For cats, every pain medication can potentially cause kidney failure. As a result, the vet most likely won't prescribe your cat anything.

Just as Plus Relief helps us humans deal with pain and inflammation, Plus Relief for Pets can do the same for our companion animals.

This product primarily treats moderate to severe chronic pain in our pets and is specifically indicated to treat pain from hip dysplasia, arthritis pain, joint pain and general chronic pain in companion animals.
